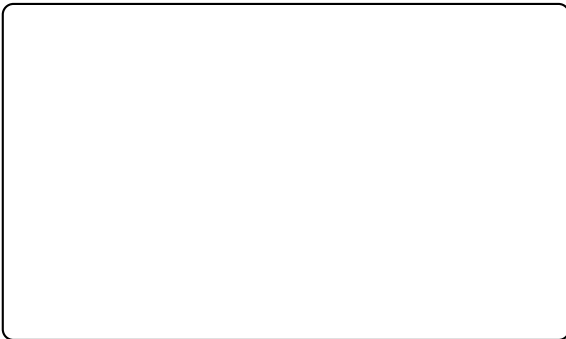
Zechariah's Timeline
